Supplemental Lessons--Introduction

These lessons supplement Parts 1 and 2 of *Construction and Design Law: Managing the Network of Interdependent Relationships*. The first two parts provide materials on the core topics I generally cover in a 3-credit hour, introductory course for law students. These supplemental lessons provide suggestions for instructors who wish to delve more deeply into topics that Parts 1 and 2 address in limited respects in connection with one or more of the core topics. Unlike Parts 1 and 2, these supplemental lessons only offer highly abbreviated introductions to the topic, together with proposed reading assignments and a short list of additional resources. Instructors who wish to devote substantial class time to these topics may wish to add their own overviews and commentary as well as selected case assignments.

Some of these supplementary lessons are marked as works-in-progress because they include only the barest of introductions, primarily offering instructors resources they may wish to use to develop their own lessons on the topic involved. In the future, I will revise the introductions in those lessons to provide more useful overviews of the topics involved.
